GATEWAY ENERGY ANSWERS PRESIDENT'S CALL TO ACTION

MONTEBELLO, NY – Gateway Energy Services is doing its part to help bring the economy back from crisis by creating up to 100 new jobs by the end of the year.

On January 27, in his State of the Union Address, President Barack Obama stated that “jobs must be our No. 1 focus in 2010.” Gateway will be answering that call by holding its fourth and fifth recruiting open-house events at its new satellite facility in Forty Fort, Pa. Gateway is a recently licensed electricity supplier in Pennsylvania. The company, which began offering power to customers in the PPL service area on January 16, has experienced an incredible response from residents and reports its most successful launch in its 12-year history. Gateway offers a fixed rate of 9.35 cents per kWh, which is the lowest available in a direct comparison to PPL’s price to compare through Dec. 31, 2010. Gateway also offers a competitive rate for its one- and two-year fixed-rate plans, as well as a variable-rate plan that reflects market prices. The company received its Pennsylvania license to sell natural gas this month and plans to add UGI’s service areas to its footprint in the near future.
