RATE PLAN SUMMARY

EARLY CANCELLATION FEES DURING INITIAL TERM (per account)	If you choose to cancel this Contract after thirty (30) days but before the end of the Initial Term, you are subject to the early termination fee of \$100.00. See Section 3 of the Terms & Conditions for additional details.
CONTINUATION PERIOD FOR SUPPLY RATE	At least sixty (60) days prior to the end of your Initial Term, you will receive notice about the continuation of your Contract. At that time, you may enroll with Direct Energy under the proposed offer or cancel your Contract and switch to another supplier or back to the Utility with no termination fee. If you do not respond to the notice within the sixty (60)-day period, Direct Energy will provide you service according to the terms of the notice. See Section 5 of the Terms and Conditions for further information.
